## Faculty subjects:

In S3 you will continue to study Maths (4 periods per week) and English (4 periods per week). You can chose a subject from within each of the other faculties for 3 periods per week e.g. you can chose to study only music from Expressive Arts for 3 periods per week.

## Inter Disciplinary Learning (IDL):

You will then choose which Inter Disciplinary Learning course you would like to do. This joins up subjects from across the school and is for 1 period per week.

## Skills Based Elective:

You will then choose which skills based elective course that you would like to do. This provides you with a chance to further develop skills for life, learning and work for 2 periods per week.
