Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all well and staying safe!

At the end of last week, we shared information from the City of Edinburgh Council which outlined what our return to school is going to look like. We will be sending out more specific information about your child and their timetable as soon as we're able to; however, to allow you to plan ahead, please find attached our timetable structure for August which gives you an overview of when young people should attend school. This is broken down into days and year groups so you can find out when your child should attend. If your child is in S3, the year will be split in two depending on subject choices. Again, this information will come out to individuals so you know which days your child should attend.

In summary, all year groups will be in school for two full days each week. We will be able to increase this time as and when the restrictions change. Work will be provided online for young people to complete when they are not in school. This will continue to be through Office 365 and Teams.

Please note that there may be cases where we can offer full provision for your young person – this includes if parents are key workers or if your child makes

frequent use of Support for Learning. We will be in contact individually to discuss this with you.

We are really keen to have our young people back in school as soon as possible. We are not only missing them but also know how important it is to have them back in a routine.
