



THE SCOTTISH CREDIT AND QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK





How Many Subjects? (S3)

- All S3 pupils will pick <u>6 subjects</u> in addition to <u>English</u>, <u>Maths</u>, and <u>French</u> (9 in total)
- Pupils will pick subjects from each of the <u>5 remaining faculty areas</u> and an additional subject ("<u>Free choice</u>")
- The coursing process will allow for some changes to this. For example, if a pupil wanted to do 3 Sciences, there will be an option for this to happen.





How Many Subjects? (S4)

- All S4-6 pupils take 6 subjects
- S4 pupils must take <u>English</u> and <u>Maths</u>, and take forward their <u>BEST 4</u> subjects from S3.

Coursing Process

- Coursing will take place from <u>Tuesday 4 February to Friday 21 February</u>
- Pupils will be called from their class to meet with the relevant member of staff.
- Their coursing will be discussed and they will take a print out of their choices home to be signed and returned.
- It is <u>very</u> important that pupils have looked at the course choice booklet and spoken to parents/carers before being coursed.
- Pupils will also be given information in their subjects from the week beginning 27 January.




My Career – S3 & S4

- When choosing courses pupils are beginning the process of thinking about their future career when they leave school.
- For the majority of courses that pupils pick in S3, they will continue with into S4. They will not be able to pick new subjects into S4.
- In S4 pupils will be asked to take forward 4 of their best subjects along with English and Maths. They should be thinking about subjects that will maximise the qualifications that they get in S4 from the 9 subjects that they have sat in S3.
- It is very important that they get their coursing right as they go into S4, as they will likely carry these courses on into S5/6.
- It is a good idea to look at the 'My World of Work' website to get an idea for what they want to possibly do one day and the subjects that might be required to get them there.


