Class Charts

We are very excited to be launching Class Charts, a platform that will allow us to communicate with you easily about your child's progress and to celebrate their successes and achievements in school.

Class Charts allows parents and carers to view positive achievements, behaviour records and wider accomplishments recorded by school staff. It provides an opportunity for families to celebrate success, support learning and stay informed about their child's experience in school.

Our system is built around our school values of Courage, Compassion, High Expectations and Success. Staff will award positive points when pupils demonstrate these values, while behaviour concerns may also be recorded to help us identify patterns and provide support where needed.

We encourage all parents and carers to regularly check Class Charts and discuss both achievements and areas for improvement with their child. Positive conversations at home can have a significant impact on motivation, confidence and success in school.
